08:00 – 18:00 1 October – 31 March

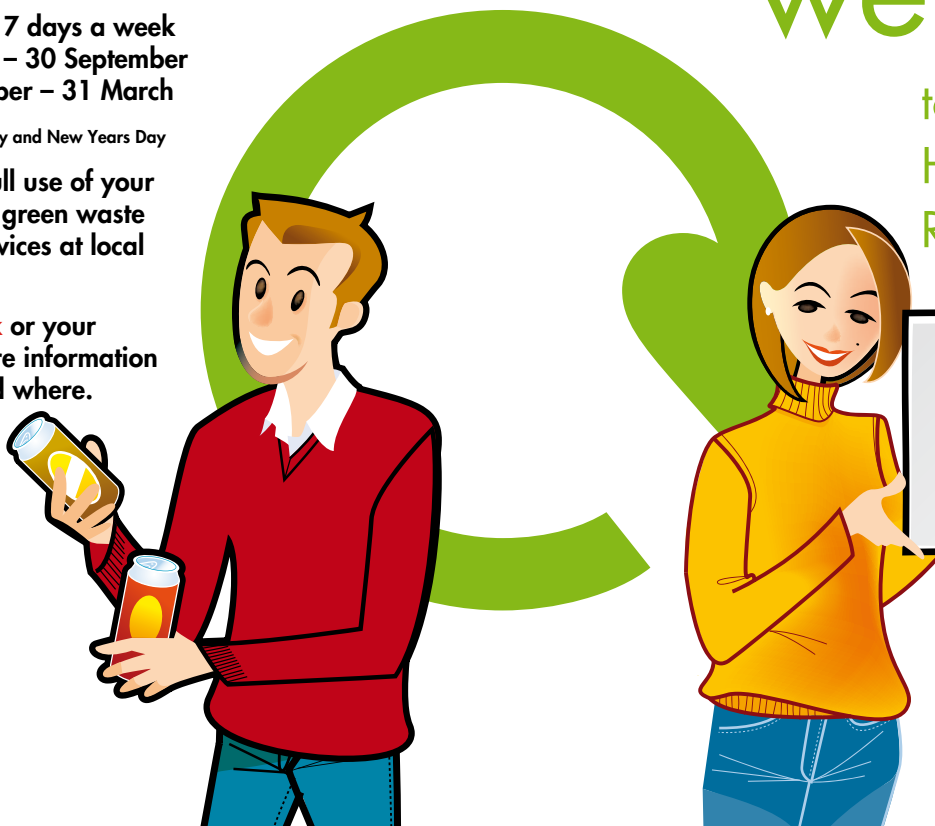
Closed – Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Years Day

zeroing in on waste

Here's how it works...



- Inside you will find marked bays and banks for different types of waste. These bays are numbered from 1–10
- Park at the appropriate bay, switch off your engine and apply your handbrake
- Deposit your waste into the correct bay or bank
- Return to your vehicle and continue driving around the one way system, stopping at any other bays or banks required
- Remember – last in, first out! Always pack your garden waste last

You can also recycle any of the items listed below, please see the coloured symbols on the diagram opposite.



batteries, books & music, cartons, foil, food & drink cans, glass, light bulbs, mobile phones, plastic bottles, printer cartridges, shoes and textiles



fridges & freezers, large appliances, tvs & monitors



car batteries, paint, used engine oil
